The paintings of Liz Goldberg, recalling the great Toulouse-Lautrec, boast an imaginative yet insightful use of color and expressiveness of line to create works that do not appear as mirror images of the subjects they portray, but evoke a deeper visual reality inherent in momentary scenes. Although both artists prove themselves to be master draftsmen, drawing upon a powerful, intuitive understanding of line, Ms. Goldberg's works go further in their pursuit of a kaleidoscopic palette. The individual strength of each figure is highlighted in the closeness of our view and the frank, open looks with which they penetrate us. This particular series, "Dishy Divas," consists of portraits named after desserts, evoking the charm and delicious beauty of the bright characters.
